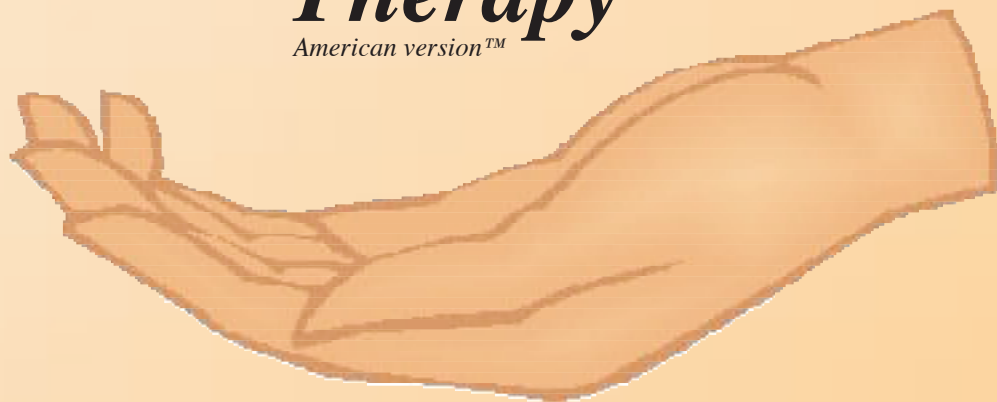

### **Why did NMTC develop this school program?**

We were contacted by numerous school owners who wanted to implement a neuromuscular therapy (NMT) program and wanted to decrease the enormous workload involved in producing a substantial new curriculum. 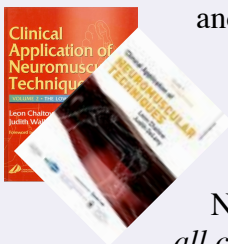

## Options Details

**Option 1 - Textbooks only:** Purchase Clinical Application of Neuromuscular Techniques, Volumes 1 and 2 directly from Elsevier Publishing (Churchill Livingstone imprint). Your staff designs your own lab manuals, handouts, slide and/or overhead and/or Powerpoint™ presentations, quizzes, and tests. The school using this option agrees not to use the terms ‘NMT American™ version’, ‘NMT Center’ or the name ‘Judith DeLany’ (except regarding textbook authorship) in any advertising, promotions, enrollment efforts or certification credential in any manner that implies endorsement by NMTC. Any school can choose this option without approval of NMTC; there is no standard to meet, no training process for instructors, no contract with NMTC and no associated NMTC certificate. *Most simply put, this option uses the textbooks - all curriculum development and updates are your responsibility.*



**Option 2 - Intro to NMT:** Order a short course *Intro to NMT* that includes a PDF of course handouts (theory; NMT protocols for 6-10 muscles) from which the school can print and a prepared corresponding Powerpoint™ presentation. The school has limited use of the terms ‘NMT American™ version’, ‘NMT Center’, ‘NMT American™ version Approved School’ or the name ‘Judith DeLany’ in advertising, promotions, and enrollment efforts so long as it is duly noted to be an Intro course, not a certification course. *Most simply put, this option exposes the student to limited use of NMT with or without the use of NMT textbooks. Choose between body regional style (shoulder cuff muscles) or integration style (muscles selected from various body regions can be easily integrated into a massage routine). You can choose one or both at a cost of \$300 per style (third party software purchase may be required). Use is unlimited and no further fees are incurred unless updates are requested.*



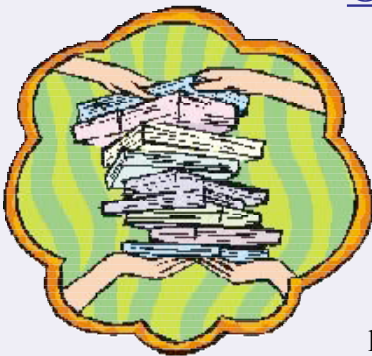
# Options Details

Our NMT program.....your school's way!

**Option 3 - Lab supplies only:** Order only lab supplies from NMTC. Supplies include a pressure bar, binder with Applications of NMT, four (4) full course manuals for Torso/Pelvis; Cervical/Cranium; Upper Extremity.; Lower Extremity and trigger point handouts (almost 120 total pages). Your staff members create slide and/or overhead and/or PowerPoint™ presentations, quizzes, tests, and the school's own NMT certificate. The school agrees not to use the terms noted (in blue) in Option 2. There is no timed contract for purchase, either party can opt to discontinue the relationship at any time and price can increase. We strongly recommend that your NMT instructors have comprehensive NMT training, however, you decide. No NMT Curriculum Mentors are provided, however, one can be 'rented' for an hourly fee. *Most simply put, this option uses NMTC's lab supplies to teach NMT theory and routines within a program designed by the school. Certification is provided by the school without endorsement of NMTC. Cost is \$150 per student.*



**Option 4 - Full program:** Qualifying schools teach NMT American™ version with NMTC endorsement. The school must have been in business and conducted massage therapy courses for at least two years and agrees to purchase lab supplies from NMTC for a minimum of two years. Lab supplies are the same as in Option 3 at a *reduced cost*. The school will also receive a disk copy of Powerpoint™ presentations\*\* for all course lectures; quizzes; certification final exam; and a comprehensive Instructor Manual. At the completion of the curriculum, qualifying students will receive an NMT American™ version certificate from NMTC and are considered to be certified NMT practitioners and alumni of NMTC. The school can use the terms (in blue) in Option 2 in advertising, promotions, enrollment efforts or certification credentials.



NMT Instructors must be certified in NMT and must have completed an application and assessment process by NMTC. An NMT Curriculum Mentor will be provided to the school to assist by phone and/or email with initial implementation and to answer questions as they arise during the initial set of classes *at no additional cost to the school*. The school is considered to be an 'NMT American™ version Approved School' and qualifies to be listed on the NMTC website. Every 5-7 years NMTC will review and potentially revise materials used in the school programs, such as manuals, Powerpoint™ presentations and handouts. Each school contracted under Option 4 will receive updated materials in a timely manner to allow for Instructor integration and will also receive guidance (via DVD, mentoring or otherwise) to assist in updating staff to the current understanding. Significant course manual revisions will be provided to all instructors and teaching assistants who are registered with NMTC at no cost to the school. *Most simply put, this option uses the NMTC's lab supplies, multimedia presentations and other teaching materials to teach foundational material and NMT routines within a program endorsed by the NMTC and initially guided by an NMT Curriculum Mentor. 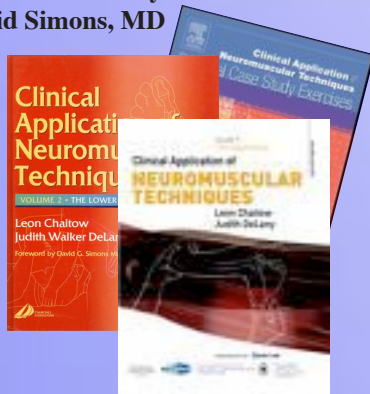

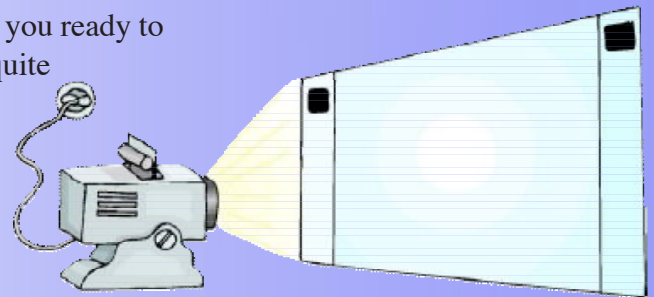

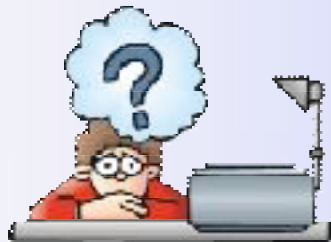

# Does Your School Qualify?

**For Options 1 and 2, any school qualifies.** Simply fill out the appropriate sections of the application and send it, along with any required attachments, to NMT Center.

**For Option 3 and 4,** your application will be considered if any one of the following apply:

- Your school is already accredited by COMTA
- Your graduating student qualifies to take the NCBTMB exam
- Your school provides a minimum of 500-hours in your base program with classroom hours of at least 150 in anatomy/physiology/kinesiology and at least 200 in massage theory/practice.

## AND

- Your school meets all legal requirements of the state in which the school resides, including approval of curriculum, state licensure, certification and/or registration requirements, as applicable. In states where no state approval, licensure, certification or registration is required, schools should state this in writing and describe any local license, regulatory board or other overseeing organization.

## AND

- Your school has qualified NMT instructors. If you do not, we will assist you to get yours qualified as quickly as possible. See p. 11 in this brochure for details.

If your school is accepted under Option 4, any associated or satellite schools can be considered without additional application fees. NMTC will then produce a customized contract for your unique situation with an initial contract period of 3 years. Renewal of contracts will be offered for periods of two years thereafter. Each contract guarantees the school's price on supplies for the period of the contract.

If your school does not meet the criteria of any one of the first three items listed above, submit your application and we will review it and contact you regarding your unique circumstances. If at that time it is determined that your school cannot qualify to apply, your \$25 application fee will be returned to you.

## *How will your program be run?*

Because we realize that each school's situation is unique, we have created a very flexible program. Our base curriculum covers about 100 classroom hours *if you do not currently teach trigger point therapy or NMT*. If you already teach these two subjects you might add fewer hours. Repetitions of trades, assigned case studies, trades with different partners and building of routines can add significantly to the program for those *wanting* to incorporate more hours. A 250 hours addition to your curriculum is possible with this interface! Your NMT Mentor will help determine how this program best fits your needs.

NMT course work is considered to be advanced material, the nature of which usually requires integration and study outside of the classroom. *It is suggested* that the NMT school program be taught at a pace of no more than 4 - 4.5 teaching hours per session, no more than 1 session per day, and no more than 4 sessions per week. Schools opting to teach at a faster rate than suggested are encouraged to openly discuss these ideas with an NMT Mentor in order to avoid overload of the student's mental and physical capabilities.

# Do Your Teachers Qualify?

The following offers guidelines for those schools striving to reach the highest quality by qualifying for Option 4. Although Option 3 instructors are not required to apply for approval nor meet a standard set by NMTC, the following is strongly recommended.



Option 4 NMT instructors (with rare exception) must have completed the NMT courses twice in either a school or seminar format and be certified in NMT. Teaching assistants (TAs) should have completed NMT training at least once and passed a certification exam. Each potential instructor should submit an Instructor Application for individual assessments. Though not required, additional assets would include prior teaching experience and an NMT based practice for at least two years. The instructors are employees or contractors with the school and are not employed or contracted by NMTC in any manner.

TAs should be provided in all hands-on classes at the rate of no less than 1:14 teacher to student ratio, including instructor (ie, 15-28 needs instructor plus TA). All TAs should be registered with NMTC. Exceptions to this ratio or to the TA requirements will be considered if a school submits in writing the special circumstances and a clear request for waiver of a requirement. Recommendations will be made by NMTC upon review of the circumstances.



It is not recommended that NMT instructors or TAs teach in more than one school except where the schools are affiliated. It is suggested that exceptional circumstances may otherwise exist and that cooperation could be achieved when two independent schools are in harmonious agreement. In most circumstances, however, schools in nearby areas are considered competitive for the same audience of enrollees. A conflict of interest could result if an instructor attempts to be employed by both.
